We are pleased to be returning to Bishop Burton for the fourth British Riding Clubs Northern Championships. This competition is to give riders and their horses the same atmosphere, competition and fun that riders experience at National Riding Club Championships. It is for teams and individuals that have been placed at their Area Qualifier in the relevant class. Horse/Rider combinations that have competed at the FOTH at Aston-le-Walls in the Combined Training or who have qualified for the National Championships at Lincoln in 2019 are ineligible for these Championships. Individuals who have qualified for FOTH or Lincoln are NOT eligible and MAY NOT make up a team for the class in which they qualified for the BRC Championships.

Riders can compete in Dressage, Riding Test, Combined Training, Show Jumping and Style Jumping. All team members are automatically included in the appropriate individual classes

We look forward to seeing everyone who has supported in the past and welcoming new faces this year.

NOTES:

Clubs/Team Managers must enter the team(s) and/or individual(s) that qualified at their Area – a maximum of 2 changes per team will be allowed. Entries will be via the entry form provided with this schedule or download from your Area website. Horse/Rider combinations that have competed at the FOTH in the Combined Training or have qualified for Lincoln, in the current year, are ineligible for these Championships. Individuals who have qualified for FOTH or Lincoln are NOT eligible and MAY NOT make up a team for the class in which they qualified for the BRC FOTH or Lincoln Championships.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday 5th August – No entry fees will be refunded after the closing date

CHANGES to be made by 8pm Wednesday 21st August a maximum of 2 changes per team

HELPERS each team must provide a helper for a full day, to be named on the entry form. Clubs may split the job between 2 or more people, but the job must be covered at all times. The helper cannot be a rider as it is not possible to allocate jobs around times (though they may relieve a helper once they have finished competing!).

Clubs must provide their helpers with refreshments.

Helpers are required for the following jobs - Collecting Ring Stewards, Writers, Score collectors, Arena Parties, General Stewards, Secretarial, Car parking, Setting up on Saturday.

TEAM HELPERS should report for duty to the Secretary's Office

STABLING is available onsite - to be booked directly – via Bishop Burton's website.

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES must be produced when checking in for stabling and/or collecting competitor numbers

COMMANDERS are not be allowed for any Dressage tests

OFFICIAL OBJECTIONS PROTESTS OR COMPLAINTS to be made by the Team Manager and should be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20. Protests must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided that there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.

PRESENTATIONS will take place approximately 30 minutes after the results have been posted. Delays to the presentation will be as a result of queries that will need to be resolved before it can go ahead.

AWARDS: ROSETTES: 1st to 6th place - teams and individuals. If there is only 1 team in a class and no individuals – then only team rosettes will be awarded. Sashes to winning teams only.

PARKING All competitors will be limited to parking within the designated parking areas.

MEDICAL CARE Paramedics will be on site during competition hours. Contact an official with a radio in an emergency.

VET AND FARRIER will **NOT** be on site for this event.
