

**BRC AREA 4 Junior Summer Camp
at Bishop Burton College
Tuesday 16th AUGUST- Thursday 18th August 2016**

Camp this year will run over 2 ½ days to include 5 training sessions. We are very lucky to have the use of the Bishop Burton facilities including their full XC course as well as their training track. All show jumping and dressage will be on a surface.

Your trainers are very experienced and established working with young riders at all levels.

The camp caters for riders of all levels, however for everyone to get the most out of these few days, ideally you would be comfortably jumping at 75cm.

Camp includes your training, your stable with 2 bags of shavings and haylage (2 lg nets per horse per day) if your horse is on hay, then you will need to bring your own.

All horses and ponies are required to be fully vaccinated and have their passports with them during camp.

There will be 3 meals each day to include a continental style breakfast, toast, jams and juice. Lunch will be a jkt potato with a choice of fillings and an evening meal served in 'the paddocks' restaurant. (lunch Tuesday to breakfast Thursday)

Juniors will need to have an adult responsible for them during their stay at BB REGARDLESS OF THEIR AGE!

If accompanying adults wish to book meals, please complete the booking form and cheques made payable to AREA 4 RIDING CLUBS and on a separate ch to members camp fee.

On receipt of you final balance, you will be sent a list of 'what you will need' along with your time table and groups.
